

## City's May 7, 2022, General Election Information

As you may have heard, the City will contract with Harris County to conduct its May 7, 2022, General Election. The City chose to contract with the County because of the State constitutional amendment election that will also be conducted on May 7, 2022. City Council felt that it would be more convenient for voters to go to one place and have the ability to cast their ballot for both the constitutional amendments as well as their choice for City Councilmembers Place 1, Place 4 and Place 5.

In accordance with the Joint Election Agreement, Harris County will perform all of the duties that are connected to the election, including early voting and voting by mail activities.
