Sunday, April 30 12 p.m. – 7 p.m.

Monday, May 1 – Tuesday, May 2, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Saturday, May 6 Election Day, 7 a.m. – 7pm.

VOTING BY MAIL

As a reminder, new state voting laws require voters to put a driver's license or last 4 digits of voter's social security number on the mail ballots and applications to vote by mail. The last day to apply for a ballot by mail is April 25, 2023. The deadline to submit non-military "late domestic ballots" mailed within the US is May 8, 2023. The Deadline to submit non-military ballots mailed from outside the US is May 11, 2023. The Deadline to receive military ballots is May 12, 2023. HOW TO USE NEW PAPER BALLOT VOTING MACHINES
