

NOTICE OF GENERAL & SPECIAL ELECTIONS

To the Registered Voters of the City of Jersey Village:

Notice is hereby given that the City of Jersey Village will conduct a General Election, which will be jointly held with Harris County, Texas, on May 3, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Councilmember for Place 2, and a Councilmember for Place 3.

Notice is also given that the City of Jersey Village will conduct a Special Election, which will be jointly held with Harris County, Texas, on May 3, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of allowing voters to vote “Yes” or “No” concerning the following proposition:

Proposition A

Amending Section 5.05 of the City Charter related to the Office of the City Secretary.

SHALL THE JERSEY VILLAGE CHARTER BE AMENDED BY AMENDING “ARTICLE V – ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION”, SECTION 5.05, “CITY SECRETARY”, IN ORDER TO CLARIFY THAT THE CITY SECRETARY IS NOT OBLIGATED TO PERFORM DUTIES ASSIGNED BY THE CITY MANAGER?

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted during the period of April 21 through April 29, 2025, during the hours designated by the Harris County Election Administrator, who also serves as the Early Voting Clerk. The early voting hours are as follows:

April 22 through April 26, 2025 – 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

April 27, 2025 – 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

April 28 through April 29, 2025 – 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The main voting location for the City of Jersey Village residents is the Civic Center Meeting Room located at 16327 Lakeview Drive, Jersey Village, Texas. However, residents may vote during early voting and Election Day at any polling location designated by Harris County.
