



DISASTER RECOVERY – UPDATE #3, APRIL 29, 2016

★ FEMA DSA TEAMS

-Starting Thursday, April 28, 2016, FEMA will have ground teams, known as Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) Teams, with personnel on foot going door to door through flood affected areas. This is an effort to contact disaster survivors regarding registration for federal assistance.

-These teams usually work in pairs going door to door. They will be wearing blue shirts with the “FEMA” or “DHS” logo and each DSA team member will have an official FEMA ID Card.

-The FEMA ID Card is a vertical picture ID card resembling a military ID, with “FEMA” in large red letters, and a gold computer chip in the lower left corner.

-FEMA DSA teams will be in operation 7 days a week for the next several weeks.

★ DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER (DRC)

-The City has requested a DRC for the recent storm event. The public will be notified when and where they are once the information is available.

★ DEBRIS REMOVAL

-Starting Monday, May 2, 2016, Ashbritt will begin removing debris from the recent storm. The general order they will remove debris is as follows: Elwood, Sue, Ginger, Lakeview, Philippine, Hamilton Circle, Colwyn, Leeds, Zilonis Court, Jersey, Acapulco, Wall, Delozier, Capri, Crawford, Tahoe, Hawaii, and then individual addresses.
