



DISASTER RECOVERY – UPDATE #4, May 3, 2016

★ DEBRIS REMOVAL

-Ashbritt Environmental started the debris removal process on May 2, 2016. The crew will be working Monday through Friday from 7-5, and on Saturdays from 7-4. The general order they will remove debris is as follows: Elwood (complete as of 5-3-16), Ginger, Lakeview, Philippine, Hamilton Circle, Colwyn, Leeds, Zilonis Court, Jersey, Acapulco, Wall, Delozier, Capri, Crawford, Tahoe, Hawaii, and then individual addresses.

-Please ensure that all storm debris is placed in the right-of-way, and off of your private property for collection by the contractor's claw truck. Per the City's contract with Ashbritt, only debris placed in the right-of-way will be collected.
