I am pleased to report that our efforts to change the redistricting map succeeded. Last month, Governor Greg Abbott signed into law House Bill 1, which would place Jersey Village entirely within House District 138, which is currently represented by Rep. Lacey Hull. Thank you to the dozens of citizens who reached out to members of the legislature to express their concerns. Our voices were heard!

Unfortunately, it was not all good news for our city last month. As many of you know, we recently lost an icon of our community. Barbara "Barbi" Freeman, our long-time election judge and member of the planning and zoning commission, passed away on October 10th. In addition to her service in city government, Barbi was also an active member of many local organizations, including the Jersey Village Women's Group and the Jersey Village Senior Outreach. In the 50+ years that Barbi and her husband Larry lived in our city, she exemplified true servant leadership. Although no one person will ever be able to fill Barbi's shoes, her legacy continues with the numerous citizens she inspired to become more involved in our community. Please join me in keeping her family in our prayers.
