City council authorized the city manager to enter into a non-binding letter of intent with KHJR Real Estate Advisors setting forth a future road map for a master development agreement. The polling location was extraordinarily busy when I went to vote on Election Day, and they did a fantastic job under the circumstances. Voters in Jersey Village are also deserving of congratulations – precinct 74, which makes up the bulk of our city, had one of the highest turnouts in the entire county with 27.28% of our registered voters casting a ballot in a primary. Precinct 495, which covers Wyndham Village and Lakes of Jersey Village, along with many homes outside of our city, also had a great showing with 20.31% turnout at the polls.
