Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Happy new year! It's hard to believe it's already 2023.

In an effort to give residents more flexibility when it comes to their water bills, the city council recently enacted an ordinance to provide an option for average monthly billing. Residents who choose this option will receive a water bill that is calculated based on the average amount billed for the past 12 months under the standard billing system. Each month, the amount is recalculated on a rolling basis.

This option may be particularly attractive for families whose water usage spikes during the summer months due to lawn irrigation. By averaging the bill, the payment becomes a bit more predictable from month-to-month.
