Dear Friends and Neighbors,

I want to take a moment to highlight two important events coming up in Jersey Village—our Founders Day celebration and the upcoming City election in May. Both events reflect the character and civic pride that make our community special, and I hope you'll take part in each.

Founders Day will be held on Saturday, April 12, from 4:30 to 9:30 PM at Clark Henry Park. This annual tradition is one of our biggest community events, and it's always a great time for residents of all ages. There will be rides and inflatables for the kids, live music, and a variety of food trucks offering great local eats. The popular bingo and cake walk games are back under the pavilion, and this year's art contest will feature entries from both youth and adults, showcasing the creativity we have in our city. We'll cap off the night with a fireworks display at 9:15 PM. Wristbands for rides are available at a discounted rate if purchased in advance, so be sure to check the city's website for details.

Looking ahead, the City's General and Special Elections are scheduled for Saturday, May 3, from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. On the ballot are the positions of Mayor, Councilmember Place 2, and Councilmember Place 3. In addition to the General Election, a Special Election will be held for Proposition A, which proposes an amendment to Section 5.05 of the City Charter regarding the Office of the City Secretary. I encourage all residents to review the proposition language and understand the potential impact of the change. Early voting begins on April 22 and runs through April 29. While our primary polling location is the Civic Center Meeting Room at 16327 Lakeview Drive, you can vote at any Harris County polling place during early voting or on Election Day. Founders Day reminds us of how far we've come as a community, and the upcoming election gives us a chance to help shape our city's future.
