## City Accepts Parking Permit Applications Beginning August 1, 2022

The Cy-Fair ISD 2022-23 school year begins August 22, 2022. The City will begin accepting applications on August 1, 2022 for parking permits that allow certain residents to park on certain city streets within the school zones during the 2022-23 school year.

In 1999 City Council passed an ordinance providing exceptions in the no parking/tow-away zones on your street. The ordinance established a permit system, which, upon application, issues two parking permits. A person may park a motor vehicle, which displays the issued permit, on the street in

front of the address on the permit. The parking permit is issued annually upon application at no charge; however, replacement permits are \$25.00 each.

### Recommended items for your Emergency Kit:

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener for food (if kit contains canned food)
- Canned pet food

### If you plan on Evacuating:

- Keep your vehicle in good repair with a full tank of fuel
- Check on friends and neighbors who may have special needs
- Persons with special needs should leave early
- Designate a meeting point with your family should you get separated
- Cell phone for emergencies
- Monitor local radio and television stations for the latest information
- Don't take unnecessary items with you
- Take your Pets
