RESIDENTS OF JERSEY VILLAGE

Are you prepared for a Hurricane? **Recommended items for your Emergency Kit:**

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener for food (if kit contains) canned food)




If you plan on Evacuating:

Tip of the Month

"It's that Time Again"!

Yes, late spring and summer is here. That means take care of yourself for those 4 hours you are in that heat and sun. Always, (always, always, always!) put sunscreen on. Do not chance it. I did for 20 years as a Pro and I am paying the price with a skin disease now. If you forgot yours, no worries, we have several different types in the pro shop for purchase.... Bugs, (bugs, bugs, bugs!) yup, we have um and you need to always have mosquito and gnat spray at all times. Forgot yours, no worries we have mosquito spray and a new type spray that repels all gnats, mosquitos, biting flies and no-see-ums...Snakes, (snakes, snakes, snakes!) Yes, we have them and even though we do not have a spray for them - be careful when looking for balls, especially around lake edges and tall grass and pampas grass. I have a golden rule when I am looking for a ball, ALWAYS carry an iron with you, use it as a "wand", and never put your hand down into the grass to move it or to pick a ball up in or near water or tall grass with your hands. Flick it out with the club far enough away that it is safe to pick it up. I hate snakes!!! 
