CITY ACCEPTS PARKING PERMIT APPLICATIONS BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2023

The Cy-Fair ISD 2023-24 school year begins August 21, 2023. The City will begin accepting applications on August 1, 2023 for parking permits that allow certain residents to park on certain city streets within the school zones during the 2023-24 school year.

In 1999 City Council passed an ordinance providing exceptions in the no parking/tow-away zones on your street. The ordinance established a permit system, which, upon application, issues two parking permits. A person may park a motor vehicle, which displays the issued permit, on the street in front of the address

on the permit. The parking permit is issued annually upon application at no charge; however, replacement permits are \$25.00 each. If you are interested in applying for a parking permit, please complete the Application for Parking Permit found on our website at <https://www.jerseyvillagetx.com/page/city.forms> beginning August 1, 2023. The forms are completed on our website using DocuSign and automatically sent to the City. There is no need for residents to return the form to City Hall. ★

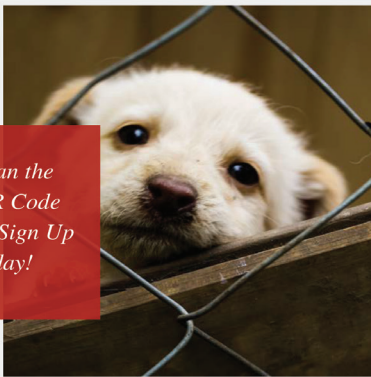
HOMEBOUND PAWS
