Matt's Tip of the Month

My "funny" teaching saying is, "90% of the swing is before you swing." It's kind of true. If your grip, stance, ball position, posture and alignment are not fundamentally correct, it will not matter how good your swing is. Bad ball position can spawn many negative problems in the swing. For normal full shots, the ball should not be past the middle of your stance. I like to divide my stance in thirds between my feet and never have the ball past the first third. If you're a righthand golfer the wedges and 9 iron might go on the farthest third line to the right of your left foot, your mid to long irons about an inch or two forward, and your driver and fairway woods about an inch or two forward of there. If you do the math on this, your whole fluctuation of ball position for full shots may move only 3 to 5 inches total and stay in the first third of your stance. Remember - a ball position too far back in your stance is not good. Get an alignment stick and put it 1/3 off your front foot and never put a ball past that point. Try this tip. ★

Yoga with Jackie





Public Works Pipeline: Stats, Tips, and News You Can Use

Swimming Pool Discharge Tips

- Never clean a filter in the street, gutter or storm drain.
- Rinse cartridge filters into a dirt area and spade filter residue into the soil.
- Keep backwash discharge out of the street and storm drain.
- Don't drain into a street, gutter, storm drain or waterbody.
- Discharge water to a sanitary sewer cleanout.
- Salt water swimming pool and spa discharges are not allowed in the storm sewer system.
