STAFF INFORMATION

Welcome to the third edition of the Jersey Village Parks and Recreation Play Guide! As we move into the fall season we look forward to all that our department has to offer our residents, but, we will still celebrate all that we have accomplished this spring/summer. We have been able to provide opportunities that allowed our residents to safely gather as we cautiously approached social gatherings, providing experiences for those with different levels of comfort. Self-guided leisure has remained popular so our staff has placed emphasis on ensuring our parks and playgrounds were safe, sanitized, and in great condition. We celebrate the installation of the new rock wall at Clark Henry as well as the highly anticipated GaGa ball pit. We celebrate a successful summer pool season with record setting attendance and our new very popular swim lesson program. We also celebrate the completion of the pool house renovation, the pool deck renovation, and the new diving board. We are proud to share that our team's creative thinking to install a water amenity plumbing line while the pool deck was removed will save over 500,000 gallons of water annually, providing much more sustainable and cost efficient pool amenities for years to come. This innovation, creative thinking, and hard work from our staff continuously contribute to new ideas, improvements, events, programs and many other experiences that align with our goal of making Jersey Village an exciting place to live, work, and play.

As your Parks and Recreation Director, I would like to once again thank each and every resident for their continued support and passion for recreation. As mentioned in the previous Play Guides, our goal is to share all our fall and winter opportunities with our residents while providing inspiration for additional self-guided leisure, park exploration, creative imagination, and constructive feedback. We, as a department, have been working to branch out the opportunities we provide in an attempt to reach multiple interests brought forth from continuous feedback. We aim to serve all demographics and have begun to foster additional partnerships along the way.

We have some exciting programs and events mapped out for the fall season and are very excited to introduce them. In addition to the programs listed in this play guide, we plan to input additional opportunities as they come along so be sure to frequent our website for updates. We also have a few projects lined up for fiscal year 2022. The Recreation division will begin the process of installing a rock wall amenity at the pool for additional summer fun next pool season. Our Parks division has completed the installation of the water line that will serve as the main irrigation line for Clark Henry Park and the TxDOT revegetation project. TxDOT predicts this project will be complete near the end of the calendar year, barring any setbacks. Our Golf division has been busy facilitating the berm construction project while completing renovations to the front 9 holes while portions of the course are closed. We are excited to share all of the changes we have made to our course. We will also be extending the driving range, completing the construction of a new restroom on hole 7/16, purchasing new custom tee markers and hole signage, and replacing the chain link fence along Rio Grande with wrought iron fencing to match the rest of the course. Phase two of the gateway & wayfinding master plan, pertaining to the large and small gateway monuments as well as entry monuments, has begun and will progress through the fall season. As public servants, we as a department are always welcoming new ideas and feedback regarding Parks and Recreation events or programs that our community would like to see. I encourage you to reach out to myself or any of our staff if you have any questions, concerns or suggestions as we continue to learn, grow and play as a team.

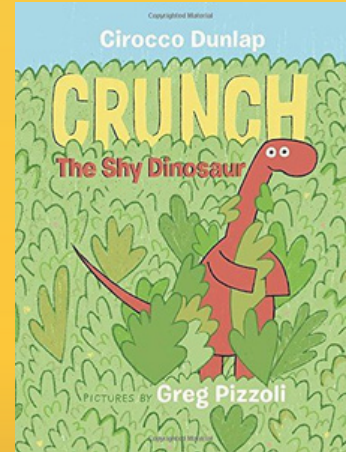
