

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JERSEY VILLAGE, TEXAS, COMMITTING NOT TO BUILD A VEHICULAR BRIDGE ON EQUADOR STREET OVER WHITE OAK BAYOU.

WHEREAS, a pedestrian bridge is constructed on Equador Street over White Oak Bayou; and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian bridge is in a state of disrepair and requires renovation or replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Jersey Village has called a bond election on November 7, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the election includes a bond proposition for THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,045,000 AND THE IMPOSITION OF TAXES SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS FOR STREET, ROAD AND BRIDGE PROJECTS, AND ALL MATTERS INCIDENT OR NECESSARY THERETO; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Jersey Village agrees a motor vehicle bridge is not required and is not considering the use of general or bond funds to construct a bridge for motor vehicle conveyance; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JERSEY VILLAGE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: A motor vehicle bridge is not in consideration for Equador Street over White Oak Bayou and the city publicly commits to not building such a bridge at said location.
